

Scholarships for students with financial need:

The following scholarships are awarded through the Doctor of Pharmacy Scholarship Application process each spring semester.

Scholarship Name: George Beecher Kauffman Memorial Fund

Eligibility: Students who show financial need.

Description: Established December 24, 1959, by a gift through the Development Fund from the Kauffman—Lattimer Company in memory of George Beecher Kauffman, first Dean of the College of Pharmacy at The Ohio State University

How to Apply: Complete the Office of Student Affairs scholarship survey during the spring term.

Scholarship Amount: 2 Scholarships of about \$1,750

Scholarship Name: Leo C. Waitzman Memorial Scholarship Fund

Eligibility: Academically successful students who show financial need.

Description: Established February 3, 1971 with gifts from Daniel Waitzman, B.S. Pharmacy '43, Columbus, Ohio, and Milton Goldberg, Toledo, Ohio, in memory of Leo C. Waitzman.
