## **Important Spring Dates**

- March 1 – Spring Session 2 courses begin.
- March 3 – Last day to add a Session 2 course using online registration without instructor's written consent.
- March 10 – Last day to add a Session 2 course without a petition.

- Class of 2020 – 7:00 p.m. You will be registered for your required courses during the week of March 20.
