- **Regalia:** If you plan to participate in the Hooding Ceremony and/or Ohio State Commencement, you must wear the traditional regalia. The bookstore will contact you when your regalia is ready for pick up. If you haven't yet ordered your regalia, you have until **Fri., April 7** to do so. End of Year Events

Below is a list of end of year events. These events are not mandatory but highly recommended. An email will be sent to you requesting RSVPs to these events during the week of April 3.

Thurs., May 4, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. – NAPLEX Review

For the first time, the College is offering a NAPLEX review session. Dr. Vincent Mauro from the University of Toledo will conduct the training, developed by the Council of Ohio Colleges of Pharmacy. The session would include coverage of the following topics: hypertension, hyperlipidemia, dysrhythmias, heart failure, angina, MI/acute coronary syndrome, antithrombotics, antiplatelets, anticoagulants, and fibrinolytics. This review will not be recorded.

Fri., May 5, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. – Review Day and Commencement Rehearsal

- A number of activities will take place for P4 students including a calculations review, lunch with the Hooding Ceremony speaker, and a law review. The review sessions will not be recorded. Further details will be coming the week of April 3.
- Commencement Rehearsal – 1:00 p.m. You do not need to wear regalia to the rehearsal. Our college's line up location and other details will be available later this semester.

Sat., May 6, 2:15 p.m. – Class Photo and Oval Procession; 3:00 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. – Doctoral Convocation, Hooding and Awards Ceremony

- Class photo and line up for graduates will be at 2:15 p.m. at Browning Amphitheatre <http://www.osu.edu/map/google.php?buildingIn=200888> – the

outdoor amphitheater next to Mirror Lake. We will take a class photo and line up by alpha order, then process through the oval to Mershon Auditorium.

- The ceremony will be held at Mershon Auditorium with the ceremony from 3:00 p.m.—4:45 p.m. and reception from 4:45 p.m.—5:45 p.m.
- You are welcome to invite family and friends to the ceremony. A formal invitation will be sent to you electronically the week of April 3 that you can share with them. There is no limit on the number of people you invite and no tickets are required. Mershon Auditorium doors will open for guests at 2:00 p.m.
- Parking will be available at the Union garages (standard rates apply). A limited number of disability parking spots are available in front of Mershon off High St.
- A professional photographer will take photos throughout the day. He will take a photo of the entire class as a group, each of you individually on stage, and many informal photos during the reception. We will make these available to you this summer.
- Dean Mann plans to hood all students on stage during the Ceremony. However, there is a provision to have another person (with a PharmD degree or of equal professional status) hood you if you'd like. Please watch for a request for special hooders the week of April 3.
- Honor Cords will be presented on stage during the ceremony.
- Rain Plan – If the weather looks questionable, please go to the College of Pharmacy Facebook, Twitter, or web site to find out if our line up location has changed. We will make a decision by 12:00 noon on Sat., May 6. If rain is expected, our plan will be to meet at 2:15 p.m. in the main lobby of Mershon. A group photo will be taken in the lobby and then graduates will line up backstage.
