- Examinees who did not receive a score on an exam attempt were NOT included in the report
- Only ACPE-accredited institutions are included in this report
- Students who participated in early MPJE® administration are presented in the data representing the calendar year of their graduation date (which may be different than the calendar year of their exam date)
